Summary evaluation with respect to the request for accreditation of the Master of Public Policy, Master of Economics, Master of Public Administration, and Master of International Relations programmes of The Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan (APA).

In consideration of the Self-Evaluation Report of the above programmes, the Site Visit Report of May 2023 of the EAPAA Site Visit Team for these programmes, and the response of the programme to the draft of the Site Visit Report, the EAPAA Accreditation Committee, at its meeting of 5 September 2023 in Zagreb, Croatia, has evaluated these programmes against the EAPAA Standards (version 2, September 2022).
